


# PUBLIC MEETING

## *Concerning Levels of PCBs in Fish Tissue in The Tidal Potomac River and Tributaries*

**The Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Maryland Department of the Environment, the Washington D.C. Department of Health and the Interstate Commission on the Potomac River Basin invite you to attend a public meeting to discuss elevated levels of PCBs in the tidal Potomac River and selected tributaries.**

**Levels of PCBs in fish tissue in the study area regularly exceed fish consumption advisory levels. The jurisdictions have identified these waters as impaired and are required to develop clean-up plans to address these impaired waters. The clean-up proposals are called Total Maximum Daily Load studies. Please join us at one of the meetings to learn more.**
