



Notification and Travel Time Estimates for Spills in the Potomac River Basin

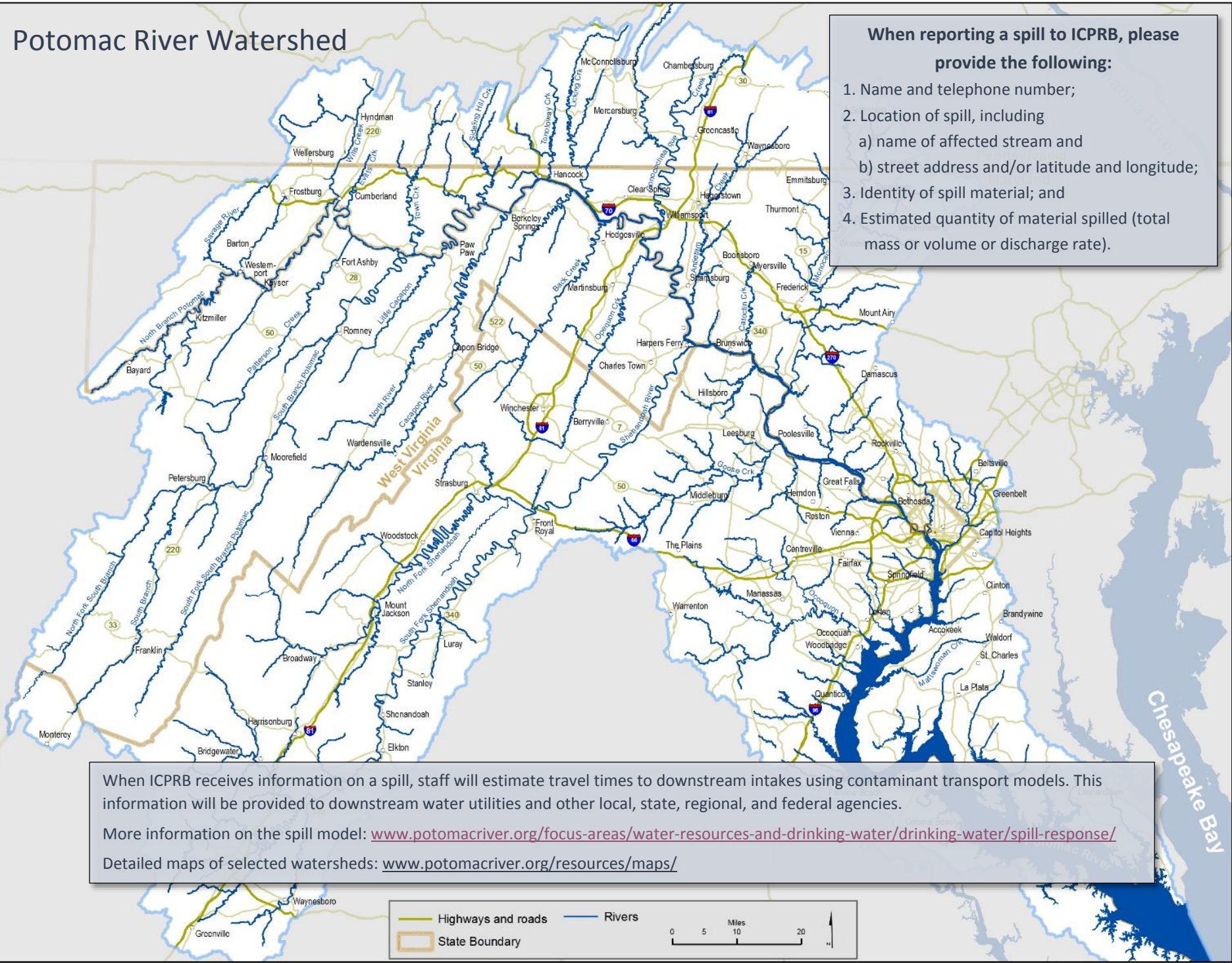
When a spill occurs in the Potomac River basin that may impact drinking water intakes, contact the appropriate state and/or regional response agency and the Interstate Commission on the Potomac River Basin (ICPRB). The table below provides primary contact information for the agencies in the basin.

Potomac River Watershed

When reporting a spill to ICPRB, please provide the following:

1. Name and telephone number;
2. Location of spill, including
 - a) name of affected stream and
 - b) street address and/or latitude and longitude;
3. Identity of spill material; and
4. Estimated quantity of material spilled (total mass or volume or discharge rate).



When ICPRB receives information on a spill, staff will estimate travel times to downstream intakes using contaminant transport models. This information will be provided to downstream water utilities and other local, state, regional, and federal agencies.
