



Notification List for Drinking Water Emergencies

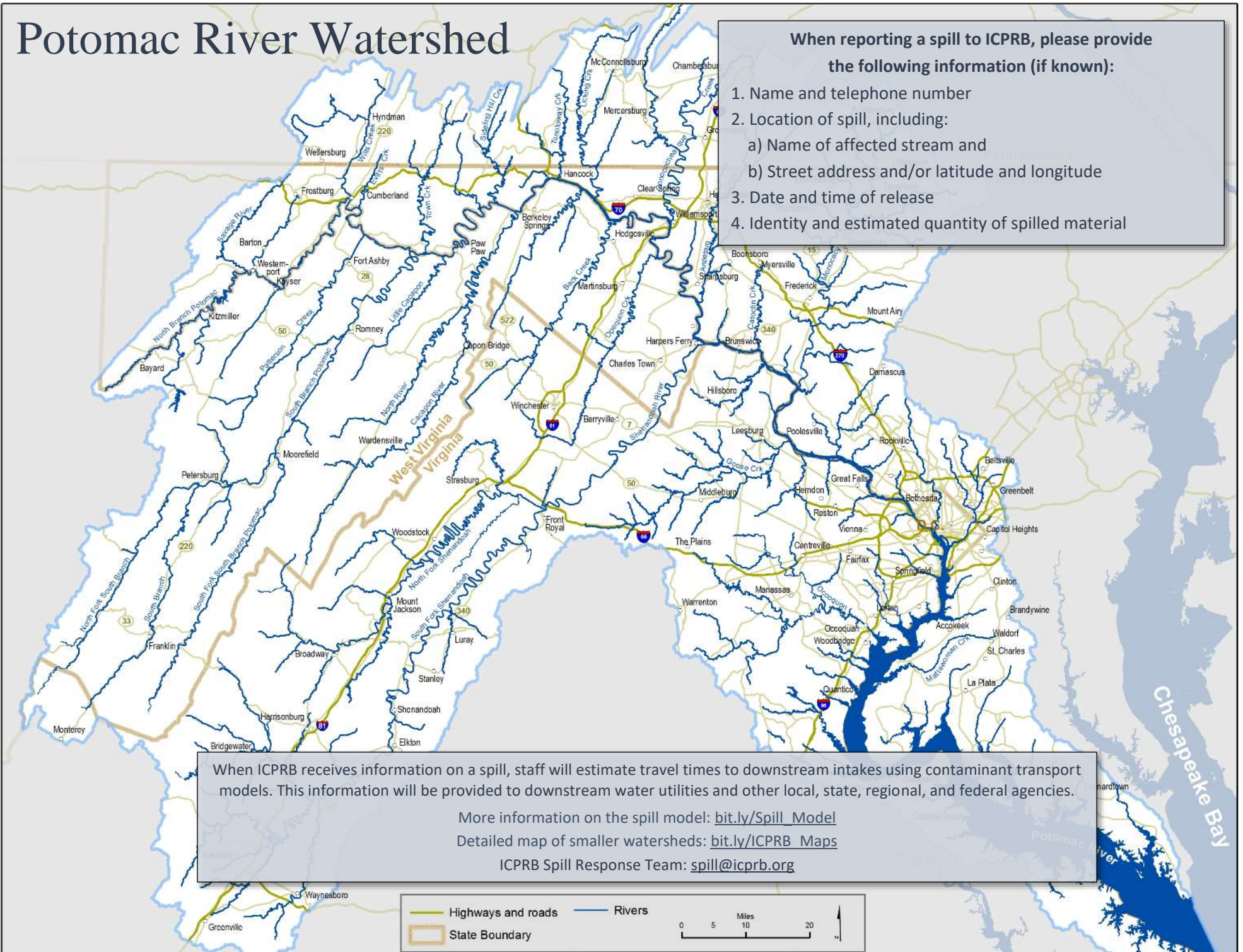

Potomac River Watershed

When reporting a spill to ICPRB, please provide the following information (if known):

1. Name and telephone number
2. Location of spill, including:
 - a) Name of affected stream and
 - b) Street address and/or latitude and longitude
3. Date and time of release
4. Identity and estimated quantity of spilled material



When ICPRB receives information on a spill, staff will estimate travel times to downstream intakes using contaminant transport models. This information will be provided to downstream water utilities and other local, state, regional, and federal agencies.
